Appendix B - Area U Residents Parking Scheme Consultation Report May 2018

Background

The council has received a number of letters and complaints including a petition from residents asking for a review of parking in Zone U. A decision was made by the Environment Transport and Sustainability Committee in October 2017 to consult with residents of Area U to offer 3 options. These are:

- To remain as the current light-touch scheme, operating two hours during the day (Monday – Saturday 10am – 11am and 2pm – 3pm)
- joining a recently introduced light touch scheme in Hanover (Monday Friday 11am noon and 6pm 7pm), or
- joining an existing full scheme (Monday to Sunday, 9am– 8pm) of either Zone I (Craven Vale) or Zone C (Queens Park).

Headline Findings

Which type of parking scheme is preferred?

- 221 (66.4%) of respondents support the idea of joining an existing full scheme.
- Of these respondents 199 (90.9%) support joining the existing Zone C scheme (Queens Park).

Methodology

Brighton & Hove City Council Land and Property Gazeteer was used to provide 626 property addresses in the scheme boundary for Area U. An information leaflet, detailed maps, a questionnaire and a prepaid envelope for reply were sent to each address. Respondents were also invited to complete the survey online via the council's Consultation Portal should they wish to. 71.4% of responses were received by mail and 28.6% on line. The consultation was advertised on the council's website, via social media and by a press-release to local media.

Results

339 valid responses¹ were received from within the proposed scheme boundary giving a response rate of 54.1%.
