**Protests on phone mast**

PARENTS and residents are protesting against plans for a mobile phone mast to be built near a school because of health fears.

Orange wants to build the mast on Portland Road, Hove, near West Hove Infant and Junior School.

Mother Michelle Wright, 38, said: “I think it’s awful. I don’t want a mobile phone mast by such a large number of school children.

“While there is no medical evidence to suggest they do cause any harm, there isn’t any to say they don’t.”

The mast would replace one in New Church Road. The owner no longer wants the mast on the building.

An Orange spokesman said: “We take public safety very seriously and all the base stations planned by the company comply with stringent international safety levels.”
