

**WRITTEN QUESTIONS FROM MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC**

A period of not more than fifteen minutes shall be allowed for questions submitted by a member of the public who either lives or works in the area of the authority at each ordinary meeting of the Council.

Every question shall be put and answered without discussion, but the person to whom a question has been put may decline to answer. The person who asked the question may ask one relevant supplementary question, which shall be put and answered without discussion.

The following written question has been received from members of the public.

**(a) Mike Preston**

*“The new development can and has been laid out in such a manner that it can be built now without this extinguishment. The highway areas in question are currently obstructed and the original building no longer exists.*

*The Highway Authority has sill decided to go ahead with a s116 extinguishment order application based on compelling reasons for future use of the development and a subjective assessment of something that no longer exists.*

*Given the demonstrated public concern and the questions raised in my communication to them of 7 June 2013, explain with justification how the committee can support this action?”*
