APPENDIX H: Mental health promotion

- 1. Public health holds three contracts for mental health promotion, all with an end date of 31 March 2014:
- 2. East Brighton Mental Health Project contract with Mind in Brighton & Hove to provide mental health advice and support to people living in East Brighton;
- 3. Allsorts Youth mental health promotion for gay, lesbian, bi, unsure and trans young people;
- 4. Grassroots training on suicide prevention and mental health for frontline workers with defined groups e.g. criminal justice system, debt and financial advisers, homeless.
- 5. The current mental health promotion strategy is revised and aligned with both the adult mental health and children & young people's commissioning strategies. This is a commitment in the Health and Wellbeing Strategy and also the One Planet Living plan. The aim is to develop a strategy by 1 April 2014.
- 6. The development process will involve some user consultation, likely to be mediated by the Mind Gateway.
- 7. An initial analysis of the city's Health Counts survey results is currently underway (spring 2013) and further analysis related to emotional wellbeing is planned.
- 8. All of these strands of work will contribute to a more robust basis for re-commissioning mental health promotion provision in the city.
- 9. Recommendation: To extend the contracts for one further year; and to offer a 'mini-prospectus' for mental health promotion in 2014-15, with a start date for the new contracts of 1 April 2015.
