45	BHASVIC, 205 Dyke Road, Hove	BH2013/03816	<p>Additional representation from <b>Flat B4 Belvedere 152-158 Dyke Road</b> <u>objecting</u> to the application for the design reasons, including clarifying the view that the building does not take in to account the pitched roof levels of the existing building and suggesting once again CCTV would result in a loss of privacy. It is suggested a planning condition should be imposed to ensure no loss of privacy to neighbouring properties.</p> <p><b>Officer response:</b> The design considerations are fully explored in the report. The college have written a letter of confirmation stating that CCTV cameras are used on the site as part of a security strategy and in areas where natural surveillance is reduced. The proposal with this application is to continue this strategy. It is confirmed that the CCTV cameras are not used to cover any properties outside the college site.</p>
