(1) Petition to stop Brighton & Hove City Council closing Stapley Road— Councillor Barnett and Councillor Lewry

To receive the following petition referred from the meeting of Full Council and signed by 660 people:

"The Council's proposals involve implementing a no right turn restrictions into Stapley Road (except for bicycles). These plans will create more chaos, congestion and pollution on Old Shoreham Road and severely disrupt traffic follow in the area".
