Appendix E - Area U Residents Parking Scheme Consultation Report

Background

The council has received a number of letters and complaints including a petition from residents asking for a review of parking in Zone U.

In spring 2018 residents in Area U were written to in order to gauge support for three potential options. 66.4% of respondents indicated their preference to join an existing full scheme, and 91% of these respondents showed a preference for the neighbouring Zone C.

A decision was made by the Environment Transport and Sustainability Committee in in June 2018 to consult residents on detailed plans to join Zone C.

Headline Findings

Support for joining a neighbouring residents parking scheme:

 70.4% of respondents support joining the existing Zone C residents parking scheme.

Methodology

Brighton & Hove City Council Land and Property Gazeteer was used to provide 626 property addresses in the scheme boundary for Area U. An information leaflet, detailed map, questionnaire and prepaid envelope for reply were sent to each address. Respondents were also invited to complete the survey online via the council's Consultation Portal should they wish to. 84.5% of responses received were by mail and 15.5% on line. The consultation was advertised on the council's website, via social media and by a press-release to local media. The consultation ran from 16 July to 31 August 2018.

Results

258 valid responses¹ were received from within the proposed scheme boundary giving a response rate of 41.2%.
