Area D Moulsecoomb Residents Parking Scheme Review 2019

Background

A resident parking scheme was implemented in the Moulsecoomb Area (Area D) in June 2013. It was agreed in the parking priority timetable set in 2017 that a review be included of both Area B: Coldean and Area D: Moulsecoomb, Match and Event Day Resident Parking Schemes.

Headline Findings

- 55.8% of respondents are satisfied or very satisfied with the current Area D parking scheme.
- 70.5% of respondents are happy for the scheme to remain the same?

Methodology

In August 2019, the council wrote to all properties within the Moulsecoomb Area (Area D)¹. A prepaid envelope for reply was included and respondents were also invited to complete the survey online via the council's Consultation Portal: Citizen Space should they wish to. 311 (88.6%) responses received were by mail and 40 (11.4%) on line. The consultation ran from 2 August to 13 September 2019.

Results

351 valid responses² were received from within the scheme boundary giving a response rate of 14.9%. People were asked how satisfied they are with the current Area D parking scheme? (n³=344)

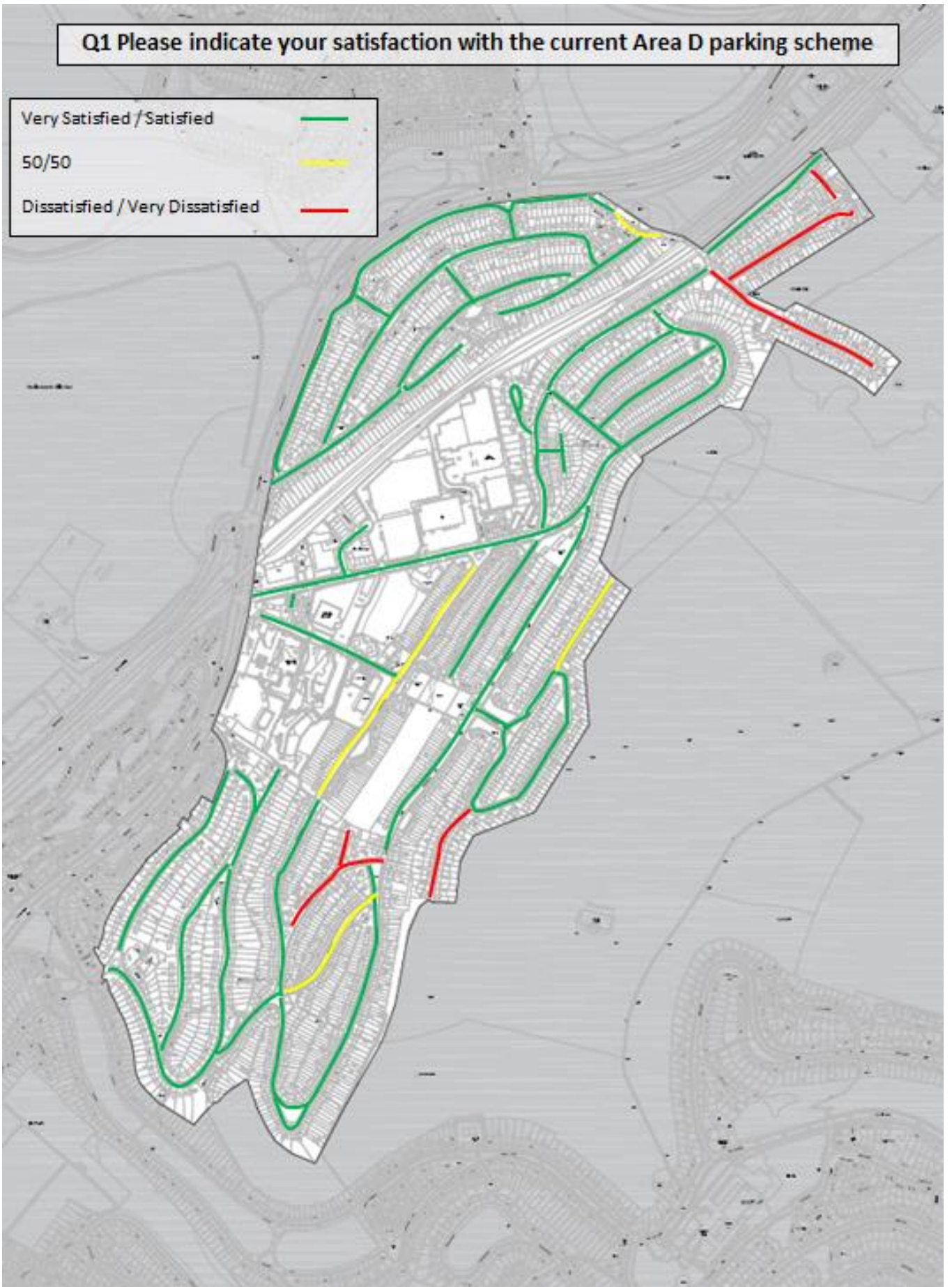
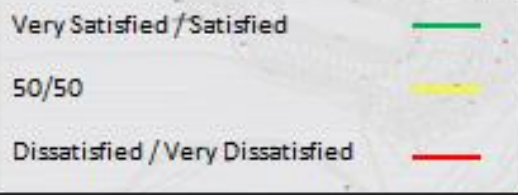

Q1 Please indicate your satisfaction with the current Area D parking scheme



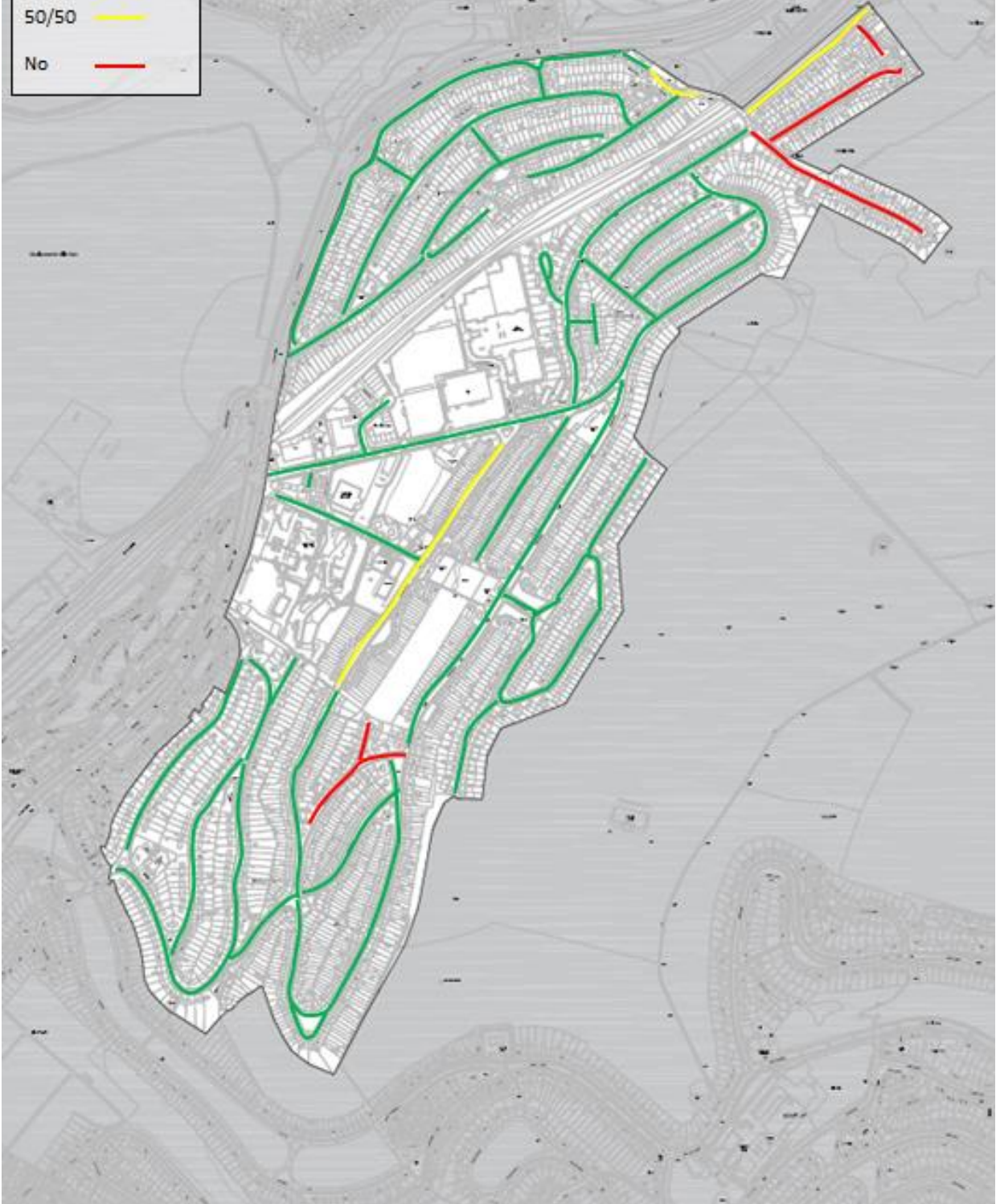
