A privately owned property, which is rented by the Council (at 101 Sandhurst Avenue, Woodingdean), has been empty since February 2022, in spite of the property only requiring minor repairs, and the fact that there are so many people waiting to be housed.

Residents are concerned that funds from HRA are being used to pay rent to private landlords, which they are then not renting out and receiving rent income from.

- Why the property at 101 Sandhurst Avenue been empty for 4 months?
- How many privately-owned properties are currently being rented by the Council for temporary accommodation?
- Of these properties, how many are currently empty, awaiting repairs?
