<b>Issue:</b>	A dual rubbish/dog waste bin at the bottom of Bellingham Crescent was temporarily removed over a year ago. It has still not been replaced. This has been reported to CityClean on numerous occasions.

<b>Officer Response:</b>	<p>The bin at the bottom of Bellingham Crescent has been repositioned approximately 30 metres east along the Old Shoreham Road.</p> <p>It was originally placed behind a railing and close to the busy traffic light junction.</p> <p>Stopping the vehicle at this location to empty the bin presented a safety risk to staff and other road users.</p> <p>The bin has been repositioned in a safer position for emptying.</p>
