# **Preston** Park

**Proposal to** restrict parking



Preston Park is Brighton & Hove's premier heritage park and the City's largest urban park. It is listed on English Heritage's Register of Parks and Gardens of special historic interest in England as Grade II, the whole area is included in the Preston Village Conservation Area and there are a number of listed structures within the park. The park land was originally part of the grounds of Preston Manor House. The park is very well used by the local community and residents from across the City. It currently holds a Green Flag award and is also a popular venue and visitor attraction.

Parking around the park entrances, the internal promenades and avenues, is currently unrestricted and the number of cars has increased significantly in recent years. A survey of vehicles in the park showed that the parking is used by commuters, visitors to the city and local residents as well as people visiting the park. Many cars are parked in the park all day and overnight.

There have been a number of complaints;

- 1. The current level of parking in the park is limiting pedestrian and cycle access to the park and causing congestion of the internal park roads.
- 2. Cars parked on internal parks roads are a visual intrusion and impact on the overall tranquillity of the park and its safety for young users.
- 3. The current level of usage by cars causes excessive deterioration of park roads and paths.
- 4. The Controlled Parking Zone on Preston Park Avenue is limited to a maximum of four hours, encouraging people to park in the park where there are no restrictions.



# What are we proposing to do?

# Create designated off-street parking areas

In response to these complaints and to reduce problems associated with car parking we are proposing to limit parking in the park to two designated areas, known as The Gallops and The Ride and shown in red. This will mean that the majority of the park is free from cars and is safer, looks better and the level of damage to paths in the park is reduced.

There will be designated disabled parking bays close to the picnic area and central pathway (marked on the plan).

Most park users use the park for less than two hours, and to prevent non park users parking all day we are proposing to restrict parking

to a maximum of four hours in the park.

#### Increase length of stay to 11 hours in South section of Preston Park Avenue

In response to complaints that the on street parking on Preston Park Avenue is currently maximum 4 hour stay and is under used we propose to increase the length of stay to 11 hours in the south section of parking parallel to The Ride proposed pay and display zone.

# Introduction of parking charges

We are proposing a scheme which will prevent the park from being used as an all day car park.

In order to fund the scheme without reducing the budget for improvements to the park itself, charges will have to be applied in the park. It is important that people who have to rely on cars can still access the park, and under the proposals charges will be kept to the minimum, and will be leaver that on street racking.
