73 Government Consultations: Neighbourhood Planning Regulations

- This report seeks approval of the council's response to a Government consultation on the Neighbourhood Planning Regulations.
- The draft Regulations seek to add more clarity to the process of Neighbourhood Planning introduced by the Localism Act which received Royal Ascent on 15 November.
- The general principle behind the Regulations is welcomed.
- However, there needs to be more clarity regarding minimum requirements, procedures and resource matters to guide neighbourhoods to produce a robust planning document. Further guidance for local authorities in relation to their role and resourcing is needed to.
- There are also concerns that the omission of certain elements from this consultation will lead to confusion and undermine the government's aims to consolidate the planning system.
