The proposed speed limit reduction to 20mph in Trafalgar Rd/Church Rd also complements the Safer Routes to School scheme currently being implemented The proposals to implement a 20mph limit in Portslade Village are part of a pilot scheme to assist in informing future implementation of 20mph limits across the City The support for these proposals from the local schools, elected members and community far outweighs the objections Research indicates that a reduction in speed correlates with a reduction in the severity of collisions Funding has already been

Objector 'has not seen evidence of any crashes' in the area	 Secured for these measures There have been 17 personal injury collisions in the last 3 years in the relevant part of Portslade north of A270 (Old Shoreham Road) and a further 14 in Church Road and Trafalgar Road. The Council has a statutory responsibility under the Road Traffic Act 1988 to prepare and carry out a programme of measures designed to promote road safety.
