**FORMAL CONSULTATION ON THE PROPOSAL BY BRIGHTON & HOVE CITY COUNCIL TO DESIGNATE CERTAIN STREET AS TRAFFIC SENSITIVE UNDER THE STREET WORKS (REGISTERS, NOTICES, DIRECTIONS AND DESIGNATIONS (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2007**

In accordance with Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Streetworks (Registers, Notices, Directions and Designations) (England) Regulations 2007, I am pleased to invite your views on the proposed designation of certain Brighton & Hove streets as Traffic Sensitive.

From time to time the designations of streets as Traffic Sensitive is reviewed in consultation with Utility companies, and other interested parties. This was last done in 2004.

Brighton & Hove City Council has recently completed a review of its Traffic Sensitive Network. This Traffic Sensitive network was developed using the guideline criteria identified in Section 5 of the Department for Transport's document 'New Roads and Street Works Act 1991: Code of Practice for the Co-ordination of Street Works and Works for Road Purposes and Related Matters August 2009'.

A list of the proposed streets to be designated as Traffic Sensitive will be found in the attached document **BHCC TSS For Consultation Final**.
